MetroParks of Butler County park areas offer great fishing opportunities throughout the county in area streams, the Great Miami River, and our 35-acre fishing lake at Voice of America Park. Visitors can access area waterways that run through any of our open park areas during regular park hours. Visitors do need a valid Ohio fishing license to fish in the river or streams. A MetroParks fishing pass is required at the lake at Voice of America Park. Check out these special summer fishing programs...

Tuesdays, July 7 and August 4, from 8:30 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. at the Ronald Reagan Lodge at Voice of America Park. Enjoy fishing with your kids (ages 6-16) while sharing an important discussion about the dangers of drugs. Children and adults will have an opportunity to talk with West Chester's Crime Prevention Officer about drugs in school and adults will get new ideas of how to talk with children about the dangers of drugs. Fishing poles will be provided. With a limit of 50 children per session, it is open to first time participants only. Participants must attend only one session and be there for the entire time.
